Dear Mr. Roessner :

On November 6, 2007, Wendy Miller and I conducted a complaint investigation at Lageman Garage (LG) located at 200 E. Bremen Street in New Knoxville, Ohio. The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) received a complaint that you were not properly managing the wastes generated at your garage. This letter will explain the validity of the complaint, the violations found as a result of our investigation, and what you need to do to respond to these violations.

LG is a service garage where you provide general maintenance work, oil changes, brake repairs and alignments. Used oil is stored in 55-gallon drums and is given to private citizens to burn in their own oil burners. Antifreeze is also collected and re-used. Used car batteries are exchanged through Piqua Battery and you take your spent fluorescent bulbs back for recycling to New Knoxville Supply, where you also purchase your bulbs. You stated that no painting is done at your location and no solvents are generated.

We found the following violations of Ohio's hazardous waste and used oil laws. In order to correct these violations you must do the following and send me the required information within 30 days of your receipt of this letter:

1. OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C)(1): Labeling:

Containers, aboveground tanks, and fill pipes used for underground storage tanks shall be labeled or marked clearly with the words "used oil."

The used oil drums and containers stored in the garage were not properly labeled.

LG must properly label the drums and containers with the words "used oil" and submit photographic documentation to demonstrate compliance with this rule.

2. OAC Rule 3745-279-22(D)(3): Storage:

Upon detection of a release of used oil, a generator shall clean up and manage properly the released used oil and other materials.

The area surrounding the used oil drums and containers stored in the garage had evidence of spilled used oil.

LG must clean up the used oil on the concrete floor in this area. LG must evaluate the used oil and clean-up material generated to determine if it is a characteristic hazardous waste. LG must obtain a representative sample of the generated waste and have it analyzed for Toxic Characteristic Leaching Procedure (TCLP) Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) metals (SW-846 Method 1311/6010). LG need only to analyze the sample for cadmium, chromium, lead, and benzene.

To abate this violation, LG must submit a copy of the analytical results to Ohio EPA. Once analytical results have been reviewed, Ohio EPA will advise you on proper disposal options for this waste stream. LG must also submit photographic documentation to demonstrate that the used oil in this area has been cleaned up.

3. OAC Rule 3745-279-24: Off-Site Shipment:

Generators shall ensure that their used oil is transported only by transporters who have obtained an EPA identification number.

LG has been giving the used oil generated to private citizens who burn it in their own oil burners.

LG must immediately cease giving used oil to any person or transporter who does not have an EPA identification number. LG must notify Ohio EPA with how you plan to manage your used oil in the future and provide the applicable documentation for review.

Ohio EPA will issue an EPA ID number to track our inspection activity at LG. LG cannot use this number for manifesting hazardous waste shipments. If LG wants to use an EPA ID number for manifesting and other hazardous waste, used oil or universal waste activities, you must complete and submit a Notification of Regulated Waste Activity form (*EPA Form 9029 (Rev. 11/2002)*) to Ohio EPA. This form is available at <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/dhwm/notiform.html> or you can call me at (419) 373-3066 or the Division of Hazardous Waste Management, Central Office, RIS at (614) 644-2977 and we will mail you a copy.

Enclosed you will find a copy of the checklist that was completed during the inspection, two guidance documents: Environmental Compliance Guide for Auto Body Shops, and Fluorescent Lamps: What You Should Know, a Fact Sheet outlining the Used Oil Regulations for generators, a list of used oil recyclers and registered used oil collection centers.

The investigation performed by Ohio EPA was conducted as the result of a complaint received by this Agency. A comprehensive Compliance Evaluation Inspection was not conducted, therefore, failure to list specific deficiencies in this communication does not relieve you from the responsibility of complying with all applicable regulations.
