Thank you for your November 2 and November 16, 2012, responses to Ohio EPA's, November 2, 2012, Notice of Violation (NOV) letter. You submitted documentation including your new universal waste lamps training memo and management procedures, a photo of a properly labeled and dated universal waste battery and a photo of your used oil container which is properly labeled.

My review of this documentation reveals that Celina City Schools (Celina High School) has adequately demonstrated abatement of all five violations on November 16, 2012, including:
