**Subject: Notice of Violation - Failure to Sample Drinking Water as Required for Lead and Copper**

Your public water system is in violation of Rule 3745-81-80 through 3745-81-89 of the Ohio Administrative Code for failure to comply with the lead and copper monitoring requirements:

<b>Monitoring Period:</b>	<b>June 1 - September 30, 2008</b>
<b>Required Sampling:</b>	<b>5 samples for each lead and copper</b>
<b>Sample Results Submitted:</b>	<b>None</b>

<b>Actions required as a result of the above violation</b>	
Step 1	Collect and analyze the required number of lead and copper tap samples during June 1 - September 30, 2009. Based upon the reported population, you are required to collect a minimum of 5 lead and copper samples. Report results on the enclosed forms 5105, 5106 and 5107 by October 10, 2009.
Step 2	<p>Within 30 days issue public notice of the violation in accordance with rule 3745-81-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code by the following methods:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. mail or other direct delivery to each customer receiving a bill and to other service connections; and</li> <li>2. if necessary, the system must also use any other method reasonably calculated to reach all persons.</li> </ol> <p>Note: Systems opting to include the required public notice in the next water bill have up to 90 days.</p> <p>The language in <i>italic</i> on the attached public notice is mandatory and must be included as written.</p>

# DRINKING WATER NOTICE

## Monitoring requirements not met for Green Meadows Mhp

*We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. During June 1 - September 30, 2008, we "did not monitor or test" or "did not complete all monitoring or testing" for lead and copper, and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.*

### What Should I Do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. You do not need to boil your water or take other corrective action.

This notice is to inform you that GREEN MEADOWS MHP did not monitor and report results for lead and copper in the public drinking water system during the June 1 - September 30, 2008 time period, as required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency.

### What is being done?

Upon being notified of this violation, the water supply was required to have the drinking water analyzed for the above mentioned parameters. The water supplier will take steps to ensure that adequate monitoring will be performed in the future.

## PUBLIC NOTICE INSTRUCTIONS AND VERIFICATION FORM FOR COMMUNITY PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS WITH TIER 3 VIOLATIONS

The owner or operator of a community public water system with a Tier 3 violation or situation shall notify the persons served by the public water system as soon as practical but **no later than 30 days** after the system learns of the violation, unless the notice is included with the next bill to customers, then the notice shall be distributed no later than 90 days from the date of the violation. Public notice issued by posting shall remain in place as long as the violation or situation persists. Public notice issued by other methods shall be repeated annually as long as the violation or situation persists.
