Dear Mr. Moore:

Thank you, for your responses to Ohio EPA's, January 5, 2011, Notice of Violation (NOV). You submitted the following responses:

December 16, 2010: fax of Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDSs) for your painting products.

December 27, 2010: fax of the information for your hazardous waste hauler.

January 13, 2011: fax of a hazardous waste manifest for the pick-up of one drum of your solvent/painting waste (D001, D035, F003, F005) on January 13, 2011.

May 12, 2011: fax of additional MSDSs for your painting products.

Brent Goetz of the Division of Materials and Waste Management and I collected a sample of your paint booth filter on September 27, 2012. On October 9, 2012, via email I received the results from the sampling of this waste stream from TestAmerica which indicates that your paint booth filters are non-hazardous.

My review of this documentation reveals that Moore's Body Shop has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violation discovered during the December 16, 2010, inspection as listed below:


