Dear Mr. Gerschutz:

Thank you for your September 4, 2012 response, (received in this office on October 2, 2012), to Ohio EPA's July 3, 2012, Notice of Violation letter (NOV). You submitted the following information:

- Photograph documentation and information indicating that you will now manage your solvent distillation bottoms as D001, F003, F005 hazardous waste by placing this waste in a container, labeling the hazardous waste container "Hazardous Waste" and having them picked by Nortru, Inc, a licensed hazardous waste hauler (this information was also submitted to me via email on July 18, 2012).
- Analytical, which indicates, your Cuda parts washing waste, and your facility paint booth filters are both non-hazardous wastes.

My review of this documentation reveals that La Riche Chevrolet Cadillac (La Riche) has adequately demonstrated abatement of the following violations discovered during the June 13, 2012, compliance evaluation inspection (CEI) and as listed below:

In addition, with their September 4, 2012, response, La Riche has also provided the request for information (A-C) pertaining to the generation rate of your solvent distillation bottoms as well as the request for information I-III pertaining to the management of your facility lamps as outlined in the July 3, 2012, NOV.

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
Nothing further is necessary pertaining to these requests for information. Please note that the accumulation time for universal waste lamps should not exceed one year (documented either through marking the accumulation start date on the box of lamps or through recycling receipts/documentation).

Ohio EPA cited an additional violation in the July 3, 2012, NOV, to La Riche. La Riche remains in violation of the following hazardous waste law as outlined in that NOV:
