The Village Cadiz violated Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rules 3745-81-74 and 3745-89 when the following requirements were not met from January 4, 2010 through January 7, 2010.

The chemical lab results from January 4, 2010 through January 7, 2010, were not performed by a fully approved analyst in your laboratory. As such, the Village of Cadiz is in violation for failing to report/monitor valid results. The parameters include Fluoride, pH, Alkalinity, Hardness and Chlorine.

If public notification has not yet been issued for the violations noted above, the Village of Cadiz may use the attached example public notice to notify persons served by its water system of those violations. The Village of Cadiz must send a copy of the actual public notice used and the verification form to this office no later than one year after it has issued the notice.

EXAMPLE PUBLIC NOTICE
SURFACE WATER TREATMENT MONITORING AND/OR REPORTING
VIOLATIONS

The Village of Cadiz failed to monitor for and/or report the results of analyses required under Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapter 3745-81-74. Specifically, the Village of Cadiz did not meet monitoring requirements for public water systems that treat surface water. These requirements were not met during the month January 2010.

OAC Chapter 3745-81-74 requires surface water treatment plants to collect information for Turbidity, Disinfectant Residuals, Disinfectant Contact Times and other water quality results. The Village of Cadiz failed to perform tests with a fully approved analyst in your laboratory. Testing was performed by none certified personnel.

The water system has taken steps to ensure that monitoring will be performed and reported as required in the future.

PUBLIC NOTICE INSTRUCTIONS AND VERIFICATION FORM FOR COMMUNITY PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS WITH TIER 3 VIOLATIONS

The owner or operator of a community public water system with a Tier 3 violation or situation shall notify the persons served by the public water system as soon as practical but **no later than one year** after the system learns of the violation (**Can be included in CCR**). At a minimum, community public water systems must issue the notice by **mail or other direct delivery**. Public notice issued by methods other than posting shall be repeated annually as long as the violation or situation persists.
