Dear Ms. Beach:

On April 28, 2008, we received Price Inland Terminal's first quarter 2008 deviation report. I am returning the original copy to you as incomplete. During a site visit on March 20, 2008, I recorded a violation of the visible emission limitation established in PTI 06-06018 for roadways. The limit allows for 3 minutes of visible fugitive emissions from roadways. The Method 22 results were 3 minutes and 43 seconds of visible particulate emissions in the 37 minute observation period.

In Part I.A.2.b. of PTI 06-06018, it states that deviation reports shall include:

"... any deviations (excursions) from emission limitations, operational restrictions, and control device operating parameter limitations that have been detected by the testing, monitoring, and recordkeeping requirements specified in this permit..."

The visible emissions limitation in your permit is considered an emission limitation and was recorded in accordance with the testing requirements (i.e., Method 22).

Please resubmit a revised version of your first quarter deviation report as soon as possible.
