**NOTICE OF VIOLATION**

Dear Mr. Boving:

This letter confirms your conversation of November 29, 2012 with Michael Sherron (Ohio EPA, SEDO) wherein he advised you that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-19-04(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, on November 29, 2012, and at 5416 Pickerington Road, Carroll, Ohio, you were open burning tires. Additionally, you were open burning landscape waste within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off your premises.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
