I have received your December 17, 2012 letter which responded to the violations found during my recent inspection of RTI Alloys at 1550 Marietta Avenue, SE, Canton, Ohio. As outlined below, you have properly addressed all the violations and issues found during that inspection.

1. **OAC Rule 3745-65-31 – Maintenance and operation of facility.**
Your letter stated this material was placed in drums pending removal to a landfill. You also sent me a TCLP analysis of the material which showed a small amount of barium and nickel. Per your request, this violation is being retracted.
2. **OAC Rule 3745-65-33 – Testing and maintenance of equipment.**
3. **OAC Rule 3745-66-74 – Inspections of container storage areas.**
4. **OAC Rule 3745-273-13 (D)(1) - Universal waste lamp containers.**
5. **OAC Rule 3745-273-14 (E) - Universal waste lamp labeling.**

Your letter and its attachments document the correction of violations 2 through 5.

Your letter included TCLP analysis for both the waste slag and RSA Rotoclone Slurry. These analyses showed both to be nonhazardous wastes. Also included were shipping papers for waste fluorescent lamps, waste solvent, and manifest 004374985 FLE.
