Dear Mr. Yacovazzi:

On January 3, 2013, I received the manifest showing the shipment of 17.58 tons of petroleum contaminated soil to Petro Environmental in Lodi, Ohio. I have also received your letter dated January 4, 2013. These were in follow up to my complaint investigation of AA Sanitation located at 4637 State Road, Peninsula, Ohio, which was started on October 2, 2012. As outlined below, you have documented a correction of all the violations found during that complaint investigation.

1. **OAC Rule 3745-279-22(D) - Response to releases of used oil.**  
The submittals mentioned above and my follow up inspection of October 26, 2012 document that you have cleaned up the spills of used oil and properly disposed of the resulting waste.
2. **OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C) - Used oil labels.**  
Your January 4, 2013 letter states that all used oil has now been properly contained and labeled. This documents your correction of this violation.

When you are ready to recycle your used oil, you must (except for certain situations) have it picked up by a used oil hauler that has a US EPA identification number. You are not allowed to give it to another business to burn in a used oil-fired space heater unless specialized testing is first done.
