RE: Village Restaurant Return To Compliance

Dear Ms. Sharon Bartow:

On December 1, 2012, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency received copies of receipts from Kimble Recycling & Disposal, for the disposal of solid waste and construction and demolition debris (C&DD) materials at the Village Restaurant located at 204 High St., Flushing, Belmont County. The receipts indicated that approximately 80 tons of solid waste and C&DD was removed from the property. On December 20, 2012, I conducted a follow-up inspection of the site. No solid waste remained at the site at the time of my inspection.

As a result of the inspection, Ohio EPA determined that Sharon Bartow abated the following violations:


