Dear Mr. Lawson:

On January 14, 2013, Melody Stewart and I performed a compliance inspection of the ElectroCraft Inc. facility to determine its compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws and regulations as found in Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

Based on our observations and review of facility documentation during this inspection, a notice of violation letter was issued to you on January 16, 2013. On January 21, 2013, I received your response which included photographs of your spent lamp boxes properly labeled and dated. Based on this documentation, you have returned to compliance with the following regulations:

- (i) OAC rule 3745-273-14 Labeling/Marking standards for small quantity handlers of universal wastes;
- (ii) OAC rule 3745-273-15(C) Accumulation time limits - standards for small quantity handlers of universal wastes.

You have now abated all violations cited from the January 14, 2013 inspection.
