Dear Mr. Anderson:

On May 16, 2012, I sent you a Notice of Violation/Partial Return to Compliance (NOV/PRTC). The only outstanding violation was for the waste evaluation of your paint booth filters. On May 21, 2012, you called me in response to the outstanding violation. You stated that you currently didn't have any spent paint booth filters (as you don't generate very often based on the amount you conduct this type of operations) but as soon as you generate, then you would have them sampled as you have an environmental laboratory in Mansfield that would perform this analysis.

On December 24, 2012, we spoke again concerning your paint booth filters. You stated you plan to sample your paint booth filters but to date you have not generated any spent filters. You stated that you should be generating a spent filter sometime within the next few months (after the beginning of 2013) and you will ensure to submit me a copy of the analysis of the paint filter when it is completed. Since this is the case, I will follow up with you in the next few months.

My review of this information reveals that Anderson Repair has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violations discovered during the February 29, 2012, inspection as listed below:



Although waste evaluation of the paint booth filters has not yet been completed, Anderson Repair has committed to analyzing the filters and submitting analysis upon generation of the spent filters. Thus, upon the next generation of a spent paint booth filter, and the waste evaluation has been performed, please submit the analytical information from sampling to me. Your results must document if the waste is hazardous or not. If it is hazardous, you must explain what treatment, storage, or disposal facility you will send it to.
