Return to Compliance**

Dear Mr. Weaver:

In a letter dated July 19, 2012, Ohio EPA provided a notice of violations occurring at John's Towing and Repair (Facility) 544 Commerce Drive in Bryan, Williams County, Ohio. The violations were originally communicated to you during an exit conference following an inspection conducted on July 10, 2012. On September 7, 2012, Ohio EPA performed a follow-up inspection of the Facility to determine compliance with Ohio's solid waste laws and regulations. As a result of the inspection, Ohio EPA determined the Facility abated the following violations:

Citation	Requirement	Action taken
OAC Rule 3745-27-61(B)	Obtain a scrap tire storage registration	Removed excess scrap tires from property
OAC Rule 3745-27-60(C)	Mosquito control	Storing tires dry
OAC Rule 3745-27-57(E)	Maintain shipping papers	Provided copies of shipping papers from registered scrap tire transporter
OAC Rule 3745-27-54(B)	Obtain scrap tire transporter registration	Contracted with registered scrap tire transporter to haul scrap tires

Nothing in this letter shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable state or federal laws or regulations. This letter shall not be interpreted to release the owner or operator, or others, from responsibility under Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111 of the Ohio Revised Code or under the Federal Clean Water Act, Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
