We have used our Surface Water Information Management System (SWIMS) in an attempt to review your self-monitoring reports covering the months of October 2010 through March 2011 and have found no monitoring reports were submitted for any of the months. The failure to submit monthly discharge monitoring reports (DMRs) according to the terms and conditions of your permit is a violation to your discharge permit.

Please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limitations or to satisfy the monitoring or reporting requirements of your NPDES permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.

Please submit the missing DMRs to our Columbus office within **10** days upon receipt of this letter and provide written verification to this office.
