Dear Commissioners:

On February 16, 2011, I conducted a Compliance Evaluation Inspection at Briarcliff Complex WWTP located in Lucasville, Ohio. Ryan Smith represented Scioto County and accompanied me during the inspection. The purpose of the inspection was to determine Scioto County's compliance with NPDES Permit Number OPG00060*DD and the Ohio Water Pollution Control Act, Revised Code Chapter 6111.

As a result of the inspection and review of our files, I have the following comments:

1. The county has plans in the near future to rebuild the sand filters. They did appear to be operable at the time of the inspection.
2. The facility is on the Significant Noncompliance list for July 2010 through December 2010 due to fecal coliform violations. With disinfection season starting in May, the county should make every effort to avoid future violations.

Attached is a copy of the inspection report which indicates the areas evaluated during the inspection. I rated the Operations and Maintenance, Facility Site Review and the Effluent/Receiving Waters portions of the inspection report as marginal. This is due to the above mentioned comments. Scioto County should take the appropriate actions to return the facility in compliance with all terms and conditions of the NPDES permit.

The Ohio EPA strongly encourages pollution prevention as the preferred approach for waste management. The first priority of pollution prevention is to eliminate the generation of wastes and pollutants at the source (source reduction). For those wastes or pollutants that are generated, the second priority is to recycle or reuse them in an environmentally sound manner. You can benefit economically, help preserve the

environment, and improve your public image by implementing pollution prevention programs. 


