Dear Mr. Schulze:

The Marysville Foursquare Church public water system (PWS) has violated Ohio's safe drinking water regulations. Specifically, the PWS has failed to monitor for total coliform and nitrate, failed to issue public notices, and failed to correct significant deficiencies noted in multiple Ohio EPA sanitary surveys.

Owners or operators of public water systems that fail to comply with Ohio's safe drinking water laws and regulations are subject to civil penalties of up to \$25,000 per day per violation under Ohio Revised Code Section 6109.33.

To resolve your drinking water violations and avoid possible legal action and civil penalties, it is agreed that Marysville Foursquare Church will:

1. Comply with total coliform bacteria monitoring requirements, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-81-21.
2. Comply with nitrate monitoring requirements, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-81-23.
3. Comply with all current and future contaminant monitoring schedules issued by the Director.
4. Enter into a contract with a certified laboratory (for a minimum of one year) within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter to collect, analyze, and report the PWS's required samples.
 - a. Marysville Foursquare Church will provide documentation evidencing the contract, including but not limited to a copy of the contract, to "Ohio EPA, Division of Drinking and Ground Waters, Central Office, Lazarus Government Center, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049, Attn: Laura Webb."


5. Post public notice for prior monitoring violations within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-81-32.
 - a. Marysville Foursquare Church will return a copy of the public notice and the completed verification form within fifteen (15) days after completing the posting to "Ohio EPA, Division of Drinking and Ground Waters, Central Office, Lazarus Government Center, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049, Attn: Laura Webb."
6. Comply with all public notification requirements associated with any future monitoring and MCL violations, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-81-32.
7. Within sixty (60) days from the date of this letter, submit a letter and photographs to "Ohio EPA, Division of Drinking and Ground Waters, Central Office, Lazarus Government Center, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049, Attn: Laura Webb," verifying that Marysville Foursquare Church:
 - a. Is using ANSI/NSF 60 approved salt in the softening system, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-83-01(D); and
 - b. Has installed a new, watertight well cap which fits securely to the well casing, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-9-05.
