Dear Mr. Simon:

Thank you for your June 8, June 18 and July 6, 2009, responses to Ohio EPA's March 10, 2009, Notice of Violation letter. You submitted documentation including the analytical report for the wastewater separator tank waste. During my follow-up inspection on June 8, 2009, I observed and photographed the sampling of the wastewater separator tank, the proper labeling of your used oil tank and the proper labeling and packaging of your universal waste lamps.

My observations from the follow-up inspection reveals that on June 8, 2009, GLWS had adequately demonstrated abatement of **OAC Rule 3745-52-11, Waste Evaluation** for the universal waste lamps and **OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C)(1), Used Oil Container Labeling**. My review of the analytical report reveals that on July 6, 2009, GLWS had adequately demonstrated abatement of **OAC Rule 3745-52-11, Waste Evaluation**, for the wastewater separator tank waste. Therefore, GLWS has abated all the violations discovered during my February 27, 2009, inspection.
