**Subject: 2012 Monitoring Violation – 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Water Quality Parameter (WQP) Monitoring**

Dear Mr. Marzluf:

The Del-Co Water Company is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-81-87 for failure to collect the required number of distribution WQP samples for 2012.

<b>Monitoring Period:</b>	2012
<b>Required Distribution WQP Monitoring:</b>	pH, alkalinity, orthophosphate from 10 distribution sites <u>twice</u> annually
<b>Sample Results Submitted:</b>	pH, alkalinity, orthophosphate from 10 sites <u>once</u> annually

**ACTION REQUIRED:**

1. **Notify the people served by this water system** using one or more of the methods and the timing as required by OAC, Rule 3745-81-32 to reach all persons served.

**Timing:** As soon as practical, but no later than one year after learning of the violation:

- Mail or other direct delivery to each customer; OR
- Annual Consumer Confidence Report provided it's distributed within one year after learning of the violation; and
- If necessary to reach all persons regularly served, use other notification methods such as newspaper publication, public posting or Internet posting;
- Posted notices must remain in place as long as the violation or situation exists, but in no case less than seven days (even if the violation is resolved). The language in italics on the enclosed public notice is mandatory and must be included, as written. Do not make changes to the public notice without consulting with the Ohio EPA beforehand.

2. **Complete the enclosed Verification Form within 10 days of issuing the Public Notice** and mail it to the attention of Carolyn O'Neal @ Ohio EPA, CDO, DDAGW, PO Box 1049, Columbus, OH 43216-1049. Include a copy of each notice distributed, published and posted.
3. **Begin 1<sup>st</sup> annual WQP monitoring in 2013.** In accordance with OAC 3745-81-87(E)(1)(a), three consecutive years of annual WQP monitoring which reflect optimal corrosion control treatment specified by the director must be accomplished before advancing to WQP monitoring once every three years.

Therefore, annual monitoring begins again in 2013 as shown in the table below. Since the dates have been revised from those in former correspondences, refer to these tables only until such time that WQP monitoring requirements are included in the annual monitoring schedules.

Samples shall be collected evenly throughout the year so as to reflect seasonal variability. Results are to be reported on the 5108 form and submitted to me at the address above by January 10<sup>th</sup> following each WQP sampling period.

**PUBLIC NOTICE INSTRUCTIONS AND VERIFICATION FORM FOR  
COMMUNITY PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS WITH TIER 3 VIOLATIONS**

The owner or operator of a community public water system with a Tier 3 violation or situation shall notify the persons served by the public water system as soon as practical but no later than one year after the system learns of the violation. At a minimum, community public water systems must issue the notice by mail or other direct delivery. Public notice issued by methods other than posting shall be repeated annually as long as the violation or situation persists.
