Dear Mr. White:

On December 17, 2008, I inspected Jim White Toyota's facility located at 6123 West Central Avenue in Toledo, Ohio. On February 26, 2009, I returned to your facility with Wendy Miller to determine the facility's efforts to comply with the violations I noted in a letter to your facility dated December 24, 2008. Mr. Dave Wittenmyer, General Manager, and Terry Treter, Service Manager accompanied us during the February 26, 2009, visit to your facility.

During our February 26, 2009, inspection of your facility, Mr. Treter properly marked the containers and tank used to accumulate used oil at your facility. In addition, I observed that your facility has contracted with Heritage Crysal-Clean to recycle your spent fluorescent light bulbs as universal waste. Therefore, Jim White Toyota has now abated all violations discovered during the December 17, 2008, inspection as listed below:

GENERAL COMMENTS

Jim White Toyota could further reduce your regulatory burden and reduce expenses by purchasing a used oil burner to heat your service area. Your records indicate that Jim White Toyota ships approximately 500 gallons of used oil off-site each month. The installation of one or two used oil burners in your service area could reduce your costs to ~~heat your building and ship the used oil off-site.~~ In addition, you may want to evaluate the substitution of a water based solvent for the mineral spirits based parts washer solvent you currently use in your service area.
