Thank you for your November 2, 2010, December 6, 2010, and January 17, 2011, responses to Ohio EPA's September 7, 2010, Notice of Violation letter. You submitted documentation including your new universal waste procedures for used batteries, photos of the used battery accumulation area and the label used, and invoices documenting the proper shipments of used batteries to Interstate Battery of Greater Toledo. The invoices demonstrate regular shipments of used batteries to Interstate Battery of Greater Toledo.

My review of this documentation reveals that Kuhlman Corporation has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violation of OAC Rule 3745-273-14(A) on December 6, 2010, and abatement of the violation of OAC Rule 3745-273-15(C) on January 17, 2011. Therefore, all violations observed during my August 24, 2010, inspection have been abated.
