Dear Mr. Ditmyer:

On September 12, 2006, Ed Pulido and I conducted a complaint investigation and a compliance evaluation of MedCorp, 745 MedCorp Drive in Toledo, Ohio. I sent you a notice of violation letter on October 3, 2006. I did not receive adequate information to abate the violations.

On December 18, 2007, Melissa Boyers and I conducted a follow up inspection at your facility.

The following violations are considered abated:

**1) Waste Evaluation, OAC Rule 3745-52-11:**

Any person who generates a waste must determine if that waste is a hazardous waste by using generator knowledge or by testing the waste.

MedCorp failed to have waste evaluation documentation or an established recycling plan in place for the fluorescent bulbs generated at the facility.

**On December, 18, 2007, MedCorp provided documentation that Environmental Recycling in Bowling Green, Ohio is recycling all spent bulbs under the universal waste rules. Therefore, this violation is considered abated.**

**2) Labeling of Used Oil, OAC 3745-279-22(C) :**

Generators must label or mark containers holding used oil with the words "Used Oil".

MedCorp had 5 totes storing used oil that were not properly labeled "used oil". The totes were located outdoors west of the maintenance garage.

**On December 18, 2007, the inside tank holding used oil was properly labeled. I also received a photograph on January 17, 2008, documenting that the tote containers west of the maintenance garage were properly labeled "used oil".**

**Therefore, this violation is considered abated.**

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The following is a new violation discovered on December 18, 2007:

3) **Universal Waste Labeling, OAC Rule 3745-273-14:**


MedCorp did not have the box holding universal waste bulbs properly labeled.

MedCorp must label containers or boxes containing the burned out bulbs (prior to recycling) with the words "universal waste lamps", "waste lamps" or "used lamps".

**MedCorp properly labeled the box during our December 18, 2007, inspection.  
Therefore, this violation is considered abated.**
