Dear Ms. Conklin:

Thank you for the information you submitted on December 9, 2010, in response to my November 29, 2010, Notice of Violation letter. The information submitted included analytical results for the sandblast sand and for the trench sludge. This analytical showed that **both** the sand and trench sludge are non-hazardous. You also stated that you will be recycling universal waste lamps through Safety-Kleen. The following is a summary of the violations we had found and their current status:

1. Waste Evaluation, OAC Rule 3745-52-11:

Any person who generates a waste must determine if that waste is a hazardous waste by using generator knowledge or by testing the waste.

- a) To abate this portion of the violation, NP&C must take a sample of the spent sand blast media and must submit a copy of the analytical results to Ohio EPA. Once analytical results have been reviewed, Ohio EPA will advise you on proper disposal options as well as plans for the future management of this waste stream.

On December 9, 2010, you submitted analytical results for the spent sand blast media. The results show that the waste is non-hazardous. Therefore, this portion of the violation is considered abated.

- b) NP&C must immediately cease disposing of the fluorescent lamps as non-hazardous waste until a proper waste evaluation has been completed.

To abate this portion of the violation, please confirm how you plan to manage the lamps in the future and where they will be recycled if you choose to handle them as universal waste.


