Dear Mr. Wittenbrook:

On February 24, 2010, I conducted a Reconnaissance Inspection at G&N Sportsbar and Grill located in Malaga, Ohio. Tim Campbell, with this office, assisted me with the inspection. The purpose of the inspection was to determine G&N's compliance with NPDES Permit Number OPR00153*AD and the Ohio Water Pollution Control Act, Revised Code Chapter 6111.

As a result of the inspection and review of our files, I have the following comments:

1. The treatment system was not operating at the time of our inspection.
2. You have failed to submit DMR's since the effective date of the NPDES permit. You also have not performed any sampling of the effluent.


Attached is a copy of the inspection report which indicates unsatisfactory evaluations of all the areas evaluated. I gave these ratings because of the deficiencies mentioned in the above comments. Since you have not complied with your NPDES permit, we have filed an enforcement referral. You should take the appropriate actions to return the facility to compliance with all terms and conditions of the NPDES permit.

Please respond to this letter by April 14, 2010.

The Ohio EPA strongly encourages pollution prevention as the preferred approach for waste management. The first priority of pollution prevention is to eliminate the generation of wastes and pollutants at the source (source reduction). 


