Dear Mr. Wittenbrook:

On October 6, 2010, I conducted a Compliance Evaluation Inspection at G & N Sportsbar and Grill located in Malaga, Ohio. Tim Campbell, with this office, and John Shreve, Monroe County Health Department, assisted me with the inspection. You failed to meet us for the inspection after numerous attempts to contact you. The purpose of the inspection was to determine G & N's compliance with NPDES Permit Number 0PR00153*AD and the Ohio Water Pollution Control Act, Revised Code Chapter 6111.

As a result of the inspection and review of our files, I have the following comments:


- You have failed to submit DMR's since the effective date of your NPDES permit on September 1, 2008. Part III, Item 4 of your permit requires you to submit discharge monitoring reports to Ohio EPA on a monthly basis.
- The treatment plant is not functioning and is in a state of disrepair. Part III, Item 3 of your NPDES permit requires you to maintain the facility in good working order and operate it as efficiently as possible at all times.
- The Ohio EPA has taken enforcement action against you to bring your facility back into compliance with terms and conditions of the NPDES permit.

Attached is a copy of the inspection report which indicates unsatisfactory evaluations of all the areas. I gave these ratings because of the deficiencies mentioned in the above comments. G & N Sportsbar and Grill should take the appropriate actions to return the facility to compliance with all terms and conditions of the NPDES permit.

Please respond to this letter by November 26, 2010.

The Ohio EPA strongly encourages pollution prevention as the preferred approach for waste management. The first priority of pollution prevention is to eliminate the generation of wastes and pollutants at the source (source reduction). For those wastes or pollutants that are generated, the second priority is to recycle or reuse them in an environmentally sound manner. 




