Dear Ms. Page:

On June 3, 2011, I conducted a Compliance Evaluation Inspection at Chateau Estates MHP located in Zanesville, Ohio. Mike Wisecarver represented Chateau Estates and accompanied me during the inspection. The purpose of the inspection was to determine Chateau Estate's compliance with NPDES Permit Number 0PV00009*ED and the Ohio Water Pollution Control Act, Revised Code Chapter 6111.

As a result of the inspection and review of our files, I have the following comments:

1. The NPDES permit renewal application was not received in our office 180 days prior to expiration of the permit as required by Ohio Administrative Code 3745-33-03. Therefore, any discharge after the expiration date of your NPDES permit is an unauthorized discharge and can be grounds for an enforcement action by the Ohio EPA. A complete renewal application should be submitted to the Ohio EPA as soon as possible to avoid enforcement.

Attached is a copy of the inspection report which indicates the areas marked unsatisfactory due to the above comments. Chateau Estates should return the facility to compliance with all terms and conditions of the NPDES permit.

The Ohio EPA strongly encourages pollution prevention as the preferred approach for waste management. The first priority of pollution prevention is to eliminate the generation of wastes and pollutants at the source (source reduction). For those wastes or pollutants that are generated, the second priority is to recycle or reuse them in an environmentally sound manner. You can benefit economically, help preserve the environment, and improve your public image by implementing pollution prevention


