Dear Mr. Rowe:

Thank you for the analytical results of your waste paint filters submitted to me by Heritage Environmental on January 6, 2011. You submitted these results in response to my August 12, 2010, Notice of Violation letter. The analytical results show that your paint filters are non-hazardous waste. You can continue to dispose of them in the solid waste dumpster. I recommend that if you change paints or primers that you have them re-tested or contact me and I can review the Material Safety Data Sheets to be certain there are no constituents that would be of concern.

The violations which were cited and that are now considered abated are as follows:

1. Waste Evaluation, OAC Rule 3745-52-11:

This violation was considered abated on January 6, 2011. The paint booth filters are non-hazardous waste.

2. OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C)(1): Labeling:


This violation was abated during our inspection on August 3, 2010.
