Dear Mr. St. John:

Thank you for your April 12, 2011, response to my March 31, 2011, Notice of Violation letter. Your response included information that you will be recycling spent lamps in the future through Gross Electric in Northwood, Ohio. You also stated that your paint filters will be analyzed in the near future and results sent to me. You stated that you will not be disposing of filters until analytical is received.

The following is a summary of the violations:

**1. Waste Evaluation, OAC Rule 3745-52-11:**

- a) Any person who generates a waste must determine if that waste is a hazardous waste by using generator knowledge or by testing the waste.

At the time of the inspection, St. John's Collision did not have waste evaluation documentation for the spent paint booth filters.

**This violation is considered abated with your April 12, 2011, response. You submitted a plan to have your filters analyzed and also stated that you will not dispose of any waste paint booth filters in the future until you determine if they are hazardous or not.**

- b) In addition, St. John's Collision failed to have waste evaluation documentation or an established recycling plan in place for the fluorescent bulbs generated at the facility.


**This violation is considered abated with your April 12, 2011, response. You plan to have all spent lamps recycled through Gross Electric in Northwood, Ohio.**
