Dear Mr. Marsek:

On April 22 2008, I conducted a compliance evaluation inspection at the New Philadelphia Bulk Plant. The purpose of the inspection was to determine compliance with the terms and conditions of National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit 01N00226\*BD and to prepare for your permit renewal. Mr. Ben Wright was present during the evaluation.

This facility receives refined petroleum products by transport truck from a BP owned terminal. The products are stored in aboveground or underground storage tanks and are distributed to consumers by smaller tank trucks. Storm water runoff from the loading rack area is diverted into a drain which connects with a pipe from the secondary containment storage area. The combined storm water flow is sent to an 8,000 gallon oil/water separator for treatment. Treated storm water is discharged into a lined pond until it is discharged from outfall 001 at a controlled rate. Oil removed in the oil/water separator is drummed off and hauled off-site for disposal.


As a result, I have the following comments:

1. A conscious effort to collect samples of the discharge has been made during the life of this permit. Please be reminded that samples must be collected if a discharge occurs during the monitoring period.
2. Your NPDES permit expired on March 31, 2007. Ohio EPA received your renewal application on October 24, 2006. Your new permit became effective on August 1, 2008 and will expire on July 31, 2013. Please review the new permit and become familiar with the requirements within.

3. Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMR's) are to be submitted no later than the 20th day of each month. Failure to submit your DMR by the required date is a violation of Part III, Item 4 – Reporting.
4. If the sample result is less than the Method Detection Level (MDL), please use the "AA" code rather than the "AH" code. In addition, it is necessary to provide the MDL level.
