Dear Mr. Gould:

On June 29, 2010, I conducted a compliance evaluation inspection at Gradall Industries, Inc. The purpose of the inspection was to determine your compliance with the terms and conditions of National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit Number OGN00011*AG. You were present during the evaluation. My inspection findings are summarized below.

Gradall generates process wastewater from a five stage pretreatment system which has rinse tanks and one phosphatizing solution tank. In addition, process wastewater is generated from the steam cleaning of all products after they have been tested in preparation for their final coat of paint. The pH of the process wastewater is adjusted prior to discharging into the City of New Philadelphia's sanitary sewer system. Gradall collects wastewater samples with an ISCO composite sampler once per month. The city has issued an indirect discharge permit to Gradall for their discharges.


Gradall's Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) Code is 3531. The company is covered under general industrial storm water permit OGR00068*DG which was issued on August 4, 2006. This permit will expire on May 31, 2011. Gradall should continue to operate and sample under this permit until a renewal permit is issued. Ohio EPA will notify Gradall when a renewal permit is available. Gradall should review and update the storm water pollution plan for the facility if necessary.

The facility is covered under the general non-contact cooling water permit OGN00011*AG which was issued on September 13, 2007. This permit expired on December 31, 2009. There has only been one discharge of non-contact cooling water since January 2008. At the time of my inspection, I was informed that all the non-contact cooling water discharges have been eliminated because the company has installed air cooled equipment. As discussed during the inspection, the facility should

complete a Notice of Termination (NOT) form to eliminate coverage under the general permit for non-contact cooling water. This form may be obtained at <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/dsw/permits/gpfact.aspx>. I have also enclosed a hard copy of the NOT form and the instructions for your use.

On the day of the inspection, the facility appeared to be in compliance with their NPDES permit. If you should have any questions, please contact me at (740) 380-5206.




