Dear Mr. Hill:

This letter confirms three visits by the Scioto Township Fire Department to your property at the SW corner of Third Street and Harsh Alley, Commercial Point, wherein they observed that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-19-03(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, on January 29, 30, and 31, 2013, you were open burning construction debris. Additionally, you were open burning agriculture waste within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises.

This letter is not a final action of Director of Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
