Dear Mr. Sabo:

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), received a complaint on October 20, 2005, alleging that you were mishandling used oil. No specific address was given for Taylor Cadillac. On July 31, 2007, Ed Pulido and I conducted a complaint investigation at Taylor Cadillac located at 6100 W. Central Avenue in Toledo, Ohio. Taylor Cadillac provides basic vehicle servicing to dealership customers. Taylor generates the following non-hazardous wastes: water soluble parts washer solvent, used oil, and oil filters.

During our complaint investigation, the following violation of Ohio law was noted:

**1. Used Oil Labeling, OAC rule 3745-279-22(C)(1):**

Any tank or container of used oil must be labeled with the words "used oil".

Taylor Cadillac has not properly labeled the tank containing used oil located outside of the service center.

In order to abate this violation, Taylor Cadillac must label the tank with the words "used oil". You must submit a photo showing that the tank has been properly labeled. A digital photograph would also be acceptable.

**Requested Information:**

At the time of our complaint investigation, you stated that Mr. Lightbulb takes all of your spent bulbs/lighting back for recycling. I contacted Mr. Lightbulb and they have not serviced your facility and have not yet contracted with a recycler. Taylor Cadillac must provide me with an explanation as to how you are currently managing your fluorescent and other spent bulbs. No bulbs were being collected on-site during our investigation.

You must respond to the above violation and requested information within 15 business days from receipt of this letter.

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
After our follow up visit, Ohio EPA considers this complaint to be closed. DISC environmental currently services your used oil tank every two weeks.

A comprehensive compliance evaluation inspection investigation was not conducted, therefore, failure to list specific deficiencies in this communication does not relieve you from the responsibility of complying with all applicable regulations.

Ohio EPA will issue an EPA ID number to track our inspection activity at Taylor Cadillac Company. Taylor Cadillac cannot use this number for manifesting hazardous waste shipments. If Taylor Cadillac wants to use an EPA ID number for manifesting and other hazardous waste, used oil or universal waste activities, Taylor Cadillac must complete and submit a Notification of Regulated Waste Activity form (EPA Form 9029 (Rev. 11/2002)) to Ohio EPA.
