Thank you for submitting the requested information received by Ohio EPA via email on April 9, 2010. You submitted this information in response to my March 8, 2010, Notice of Violation. The documentation you submitted included: photographs showing that the contaminated soil around the used oil containers had been properly cleaned up, and that used containers were properly labeled, and also analytical results of used oil contaminated waste generated during cleanup. The analysis showed that the waste was non-hazardous.

My review of this documentation reveals that Toledo Metal Spinning Co. has now abated all the violations discovered during the December 2, 2004, and January 26, 2010, inspections as listed below:
