Reference: Failure to Submit a Drinking Water Source Protection Plan

Dear Mr. Lorenz:

On April 26, 2010, Ohio EPA issued the City of Westerville a plan approval letter for new public drinking water supply wells. As a condition of plan approval you were instructed to provide a drinking water source protection plan by April 26, 2012. Since Ohio EPA has not received this plan, your system is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-91-10.

To return to compliance, you need to submit a drinking water source protection plan within 90 days to Ohio EPA at the address printed at the bottom of this letterhead (attention Barb Lubberger, Division of Drinking and Ground Waters). As we discussed by phone on Friday, February 22, on March 6th Michael Bondoc and I will meet with you in Westerville to discuss how we can assist in completing your plan within that timeframe.
