Re: Notice-of-Violation Regarding Quarterly Fee Report Submittal

Dear Mr. Welch:

Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 3734.57.5(A) states " the board of county commissioners of a county solid waste management district ... that is ... receiving fee revenue under division (B) of 3734.57 ..., within thirty days after the end of each calendar quarter, shall submit to the director of environmental protection a report containing all of the following information for that preceding quarter:

- (1) The specific fees levied by the district;
- (2) Revenues received by the district during the quarter from each of those sources, as applicable;
- (3) All district planning account balances;
- (4) The amount and use of revenues spent;
- (5) Certification statement that the information in the report is true and accurate. "

The Huron County Solid Waste Management District (District) did not submit its fourth quarter fee report for 2012 by February 15, 2013. Therefore, the District is in violation of ORC 3734.57.5 for failing to submit its quarterly fee report to the director of Ohio EPA.

Please respond to this letter within fifteen days of receiving this correspondence, in writing, indicating your intentions and actions taken to correct the above cited violations.
