Dear Mr. Frick:

On October 10, 2012, I performed a compliance inspection of the Olde Towne Cleaners to determine its compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws and regulations as found in Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

Based on our observations and review of facility documentation during this inspection, a Notice of Violation (NOV) was issued on October 16, 2012. On January 16, 2013, I received a response from you which included receipts for the perchloroethylene hazardous wastes and you are using Safety Kleen to recycle your spent lamps. On January 28, 2013, a second NOV was issued to you regarding waste evaluation of the spent filters from your Stoddard Solvent machine. On February 25, 2013, I received the sample results for your carbon filters. Based on this documentation, you have returned to compliance with the following regulation:

- i) OAC rule 3745-52-11 Hazardous waste determination.

The results indicate that the filters are non-hazardous. You have now abated all violations cited from the October 10, 2012 inspection.
