Dear Mr. Greiner:

Northwestern Water and Sewer District–Portage/Rudolph is in violation of Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6109 as follows:

In violation of OAC 3745-83-01 (F)(2), the public water system failed to report free or combined chlorine residual daily at the plant tap. There were 31 days during the month in which the analysis was not performed.

Northwestern Water and Sewer District–Portage/Rudolph must take immediate action to resolve this/these violation(s). Ohio EPA may take action to enforce the requirements of its drinking water rules. A civil penalty could be assessed as part of this enforcement action. Your response to this letter is required by April 8, 2013.
