Dear Mr. and Mrs. Clum:

In December of 2012, I met with you, Mr. Clum at your request to determine if you could meet the 1,000 foot requirement for the open burning of agricultural wastes in a restricted area. To open burn agricultural wastes in a restricted area you must be at least 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building not on your property. By using a range finder we determined that there were locations on your farm where you would meet the 1,000 foot distance requirement. As I explained at that time, you would be required to submit a Notification of Intent to Conduct Open Burning to the Ohio EPA prior to the burn.

On December 26, 2012, Ohio EPA received a Notification of Intent to Conduct Open Burning from you. You informed Ohio EPA of your intent to burn agricultural wastes generated on the premises as permitted by Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-19-03 (C)(3).

Your notification was accepted. On January 11, 2013, you requested a written response from Ohio EPA to acknowledge the receipt of and acceptance of your notification. In reviewing the Ohio Basic Code that was adopted by the Village of Thornville, it was determined that the Ohio Basic Code requirements for open burning agricultural wastes in a restricted area are the same as the Ohio EPA rules.
