Dear Mrs. Belton:

Water samples collected weekly have been analyzed and evaluated for iron and manganese. The iron or manganese results exceed the secondary maximum contaminant level (SMCL) for iron or manganese. Rule 3745-82-02 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) has set the SMCL for iron at 0.03 mg/L and manganese at 0.05 mg/L.

The Rex Hill Mobile Estates continues to exceed the SMCL for both iron and manganese. The following table identifies those dates where the iron or manganese levels were over the SMCL for the past several months:
