Dear Mr. Logsdon:

In a letter dated December 11, 2012, Ohio EPA provided notice of a violation occurring at Port Clinton Landfill located at 530 North Camp Road in Port Clinton, Ottawa County, Ohio. The violation was originally communicated to you during an exit conference following an inspection conducted on November 20, 2012. On November 21, 2012, Ohio EPA received correspondence from Port Clinton Landfill that documents abatement of the following violation:

OAC Rule 3745-27-19(K)(1)	Contain, control and repair a leachate outbreak	Repaired leachate outbreak (email with pictures dated November 21, 2012)

Nothing in this letter shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable state or federal laws or regulations. This letter shall not be interpreted to release the owner or operator, or others, from responsibility under Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111 of the Ohio Revised Code or under the Federal Clean Water Act, Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
