Dear Ms. Spencer:

This office received the 2008 Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) for the Village of Murray City public water system on July 2, 2009. As submitted, Murray City's water system is in violation of the OAC Rules 3745-96-01 through 04 for failure to comply with the CCR requirements. Specifically, the following deficiencies were noted:

1. Required information was omitted from the "Table of Detected Contaminants". Specifically, the results of the Total Organic Carbon (TOC) sampling completed by Burr Oak was missing. The required language explaining those TOC results was also left out.
2. The Monitoring & Reporting violation received on September 25, 2008 for failure to collect the required bacteriological sample in August 2008 was not included.
3. No "Good Faith Effort" for distribution to non-bill paying consumers was completed.
4. While not a violation, please note that the paragraph describing Turbidity is inaccurate. Burr Oak's 2005 data was included instead of the 2008 results.

Be sure to correct the aforementioned problems in your next CCR. The next report for calendar year 2009 must be sent to your customers no later than July 1, 2010. A copy of the CCR along with a Certification Form must be submitted to this office at the above address. Violations in future reports may result in further enforcement action.
