Thank you for your March 20, 2013 response to Ohio EPA's March 11, 2013 Notice of Violation letter. The documentation you submitted consisted of a written description that describes how spent fluorescent lamps will be managed at Crooksville K-8 and all other schools in the Crooksville Exempted Village School District. The description indicates that spent fluorescent lamps and ballasts will be managed as a universal waste and recycled, and that arrangements have been made with American Light Company for recycling of spent lamps generated by the school district.

My review of this documentation reveals that Crooksville K-8 has now abated the violation discovered during the March 5, 2013 hazardous waste inspection.
