Dear Mr. Sode:

On December 11, 2012, I performed a compliance inspection of the Precision Fabrication and Stamping, Inc. facility to determine its compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws and regulations as found in Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

Based on our observations during this inspection, a notice of violation was issued to you on December 19, 2012. On January 22, February 8 and March 8, 2013 I received responses from you which included documentation indicating that you had evaluated your solvent wipes, you were collecting your spent fluorescent lamps for recycling by Linden Lighting and that your used oil will be picked up by Crystal Clean. Therefore, you have returned to compliance with the following hazardous waste regulations:

- i) OAC rule 3745-52-11 Hazardous waste determination;
- ii) OAC rule 3745-279-24, Off-site shipments of used oil by generators.

You have now abated all violations cited from the December 19, 2012 inspection.
