Thank you for your responses to Ohio EPA's February 6, 2013, Notice of Violation letter. Mr. Arthur Bukowski, Purchasing Agent, Maass Midwest Mfg., submitted the following responses on your behalf:

February 14, 2013: via email a certificate of recycling from Fluorecycle, Inc. indicating that lamps from your facility are recycled;

March 21, 2013: Mr. Bukowski emailed stating that he had submitted the annual reports for 2010 and 2011. I checked and these annual reports were submitted to the Ohio EPA, Division of Materials and Waste Management on March 8, 2013.

My review of this information reveals that Dicken Brass Foundry has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violation discovered during the January 16, 2013, inspection as listed below:


In addition you have satisfied the Area of Concern with your February 14, 2013, response.
