This letter confirms several visits to your property at 521 S. Fayette Street, Washington Court House, Ohio by the Washington Court House Fire Department wherein they observed that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code(OAC) 3745-19-03(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, on October 10, 2012, you were open burning landscape waste within a restricted area and also within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises.

Additionally, on November 18, 2012, you were again open burning landscape waste within a restricted area and also within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises.

Also, on April 8, 2013, you were again open burning landscape waste within a restricted area and also within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
