## NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Vanoy:

This letter confirms my visit to your property at 6140 Bear Hollow Road, Newark, Ohio wherein I observed that you have been open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code rule 3745-19-03(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, at 6140 Bear Hollow Road, Newark, you have been open burning fiberglass materials, miscellaneous plastic materials, furniture, etc. Additionally, this open burning was occurring within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises. Also, the magnitude of the burning suggests that the material being burned was not generated on site.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
