**RE: NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOR FAILURE TO INITIATE FIELD WORK IN
ACCORDANCE WITH APPROVED WORK PLAN**

Dear Mr. Good:

On February 24, 2011, Ohio EPA sent you an approval letter for the Revised Camden Ground Water Investigation Work Plan (Work Plan), dated February 16, 2011. This letter stated that the additional Ohio EPA comments on the work plan should be incorporated into the Work Plan and implemented during the course of the investigation. The letter also stated that you should implement the investigation in accordance with the schedule in the approved Work Plan. On Page 5 of the Work Plan, it states that the proposed activities will commence upon approval of the Work Plan by the Ohio EPA. The schedule also states that the proposed field work should begin 2 weeks after approval of the Work Plan (or no later than March 10, 2011).

On March 2, 2011, Ohio EPA received a call from Mr. Leon Simpson, Reynolds, Inc. Mr. Simpson stated that he was calling on your behalf to request a two to three week extension to initiate the proposed field work. However Ohio EPA never received a formal extension request or a revised schedule.

Failure to implement the Work Plan in accordance with the approved schedule is a violation of the *Director's Final Findings and Orders between Good Rail and Truck Transfer, Inc. and Ohio EPA*, effective December 22, 2010 (Orders) and is subject to enforcement. Ohio EPA reserves the right to seek legal and/or equitable relief to enforce the terms and conditions of these Orders.

Due to the ongoing impacts to the Village of Camden's well field, it is urgent that the ground water investigation to determine the nature and extent of salt contamination begin as soon as possible. Therefore, no later than five (5) days of receipt of this letter, please notify Ohio EPA as to your intentions to comply with these Orders.


