Subject: Minor Violation of the Consumer Confidence Report Requirements

Ohio EPA received the Village of Bolivar Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) for 2006. The CCR was reviewed for the required content. Based on our review, the Village of Bolivar water system is in violation of rules 3745-96-01 through 04 of the Ohio Administrative Code for failure to comply with the CCR requirements. The following violations were noted:

- some of the data in the Table of Detected Contaminants was not accurate; Lead, copper, fluoride, barium and total chlorine
- MDL was used and not included in the definitions.
- Total Chlorine, TTHM and HAA5 results must be included in the table.
- with the exception of lead, non-detected contaminants should not be included in the table of detected contaminants.
- two, 2005 dates were not changed to 2006.

Be sure to correct the violation(s) as appropriate in your next CCR. The next report for calendar year 2007 must be sent to your customers no later than June 30, 2008. A copy of the CCR along with a Certification Form must be submitted to this office no later than July 1, 2008.
