**Re: NOTICE OF VIOLATION - Compliance Test Not Completed in Accordance with  
Section E.1.a of PTI-01-12182 issued on February 21, 2008**

Dear Mr. Davis:

Ohio EPA, Central District Office, Division of Air Pollution Control, determined that TS Trim Industries, Inc. did not complete stack testing in accordance with Section E.1.a of PTI-01-12182 by demonstrating compliance with the 90% destruction efficiency across the thermal oxidizer for the VOC emissions vented to it from booths R019, R020, R021 and R029 within six months of permit-to-install (PTI) issuance.

TS Trim violated the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3704.05(c) for violating the terms and conditions of PTI 01-12182. Be advised, ORC rule 3704.05(c) states:

*"No person who is a holder of a permit issued under division (F) or (G) of section 3704.03 of the Revised Code shall violate any of its terms or conditions."*

In order to address these compliance deficiencies, please submit the following compliance plan and schedule for each of the aforementioned emissions units. Submit this plan to the attention of John Kirwin.


