**Re: Notice of Violation: Installation and operation of air contaminant sources  
without permits required by Ohio Administrative Code  
3745-31-02 and 3745-35-02**

Dear Mr. Ali:

Ohio Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC), Central District Office (CDO) is sending you this letter because 1001 Nights Auto Body Shop has not responded to a previous Notice of Violation (NOV) letter (attached) sent by this office on September 5, 2007. The NOV requested the submittal of PTI and PTO applications as required by Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rules 3745-31-02 and 3745-35-02, respectively. United States Postal records indicate that the letter was delivered September 13, 2007. In addition, a CDO inspector spoke with a Ms. Brannam, who manages the facility, and she confirmed delivery of the letter. She also confirmed that she had contacted a Mr. James Carney of the Office of Compliance Assistance and Pollution Prevention regarding receiving his services to assist in filling out the applications.

On October 19, 2007, a CDO inspector visited your facility to tell you that the 30 day time limit had expired and that the PTI and PTO applications should be submitted as soon as possible. At that time you said you would deliver them to CDO's office. On or about October 22, 2007 (regarding another complaint received about 1001 Nights Auto Body Shop), a CDO inspector spoke with you again regarding the submittal of the requested PTI and PTO applications. To date, CDO has not received the required applications.

This office again requests that 1001 Nights Auto Body Shop submit the above referenced applications with associated EAC forms as soon as possible, but no later than ten (10) days after receipt of this letter.

Please note that Ohio EPA has the authority to seek civil penalties as provided in Section 3704.06 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC). This letter or information submitted pursuant to this letter does not constitute a waiver of Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in the ORC. The decision on whether or not to seek such penalties will be made by Ohio EPA at a later date. Please note that failure to respond to this letter within the specified time frame may result in my referring 1001 Nights Auto Body Shop to Ohio Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Air Pollution Control Enforcement Committee.
